

#### **SHOE POLICY**

Please always take your shoes off when boarding and place them in the specially appointed basket.



#### **SMOKING**

Smoking is only permitted in exterior designated areas.



#### WC

Please be aware that under no circumstances should you throw toilet paper or other objects in the toilets.



#### WATER

Fresh water consumption on board should be made responsibly.

This means taking short showers and adhering to other water restriction guidelines.



#### THE GALLEY

Besides being a place of constant preparation, the galley (kitchen) is where Crew take time to eat and rest during the day. We therefore ask you to be considerate and visit only after having been invited to do so. It is also helpful to inform the Chef when you plan to eat ashore instead of on board.



### **GUESTS**

Your guests are very welcome aboard! Please notify the Captain, the Crew and the Chef on time, so that they can make the necessary preparations.



### **LIFE JACKETS & FIRST AID KIT**

Safety is the prime responsibility for the Captain and Crew, and they take it very seriously.

You will have a safety briefing about life jackets, life rafts and first aid kit, so ensure you digest the information given.



### **CABIN & WC PORTHOLES**

Please make sure that your cabin and WC portholes are safely closed before the yacht sails.



# LAUNDRY

Laundry services are not provided on board, yet may be procured in one of the ports visited. Kindly inform the crew on time so they may arrange this for you.
